



1st AGUINALDO JUNIOR OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP (RED JACKET) June 12 - 15, 2017

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. GENERAL

The 1st Aguinaldo Junior Open Championship will be managed by a Tournament Committee whose decision in all matters relating to the Championship shall be final. This event is organized by Camp Aguinaldo Junior and sanctioned by the National Golf Association of the Philippines (NGAP).

2. ELIGIBILITY

- *. The championship is open to all golfers, who are Amateurs in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A Rules Limited.
- *. Must be 18 years old or below at the date of the tournament (June 12, 2017)
- *. Certification of the player's handicap index must be presented upon registration.

The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without giving any reason. The field will be limited to xxxx players.

3. FORMAT OF COMPETITION

A. Championship Division

The Championship (Open) division shall be decided by stroke play over 4 rounds of 18 holes each, subject to the Committee's right in the event of circumstances which makes the playing of 72 holes impracticable, to cancel any round or rounds at its discretion.

There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes of play and the field shall be reduced (announced after the entry has been closed) to the top xxxx leading players and ties.

Players must be 13 years old and above or younger players who opt to compete in this division, provided that a player who competes in the Championship Division cannot compete in the other divisions.

The winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest GROSS score at the end of the Championship.

B. Class Division Event: Boys/Girls combined

The event shall be held in conjunction with the Championship Division starting on June 14-15, 2017. It shall be decided by Molave scoring format over 36 holes (first two rounds).

The winner shall be given to the player who returns the highest score over 36 holes.

Class Division:

- A. 15-18 yrs old at the time of tournament
- B. 13-14 yrs old at the time of tournament
- C. 11-12 yrs old at the time of tournament
- D. 10 and below old at the time of tournament

4. TEES

Boys Championship Division and Class A will tee off from the Gold Tees
Class B will tee off from the Blue Tees
Class C will tee off from the White Tees
Class D will tee off from the Red Tees
Girls Championship Division and Class A, Class B will tee off from the White Tees
Class C and Class D will tee off from the Red Tees

5. AWARDS

The CHAMPION(s) will receive a **RED JACKET, US Round Trip Ticket, 1 Year Membership at CAGC, Perpetual Trophy**....one for BOYS and one for GIRLS based only on the 4 day scores.

The champion, runner-up and 3rd place in each division will be **awarded with trophies and gift certificate.**

6. DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICE

In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player use a distance-measuring to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

7. REGISTRATION FEE

P2,500.00 – Class Division (Caddy Excluded)

Deadline for submission of entries and registration fee payment will be strictly implemented.
