







# 2018 Philippine Junior Amateur Open Golf Championship (Stroke Play) April 3-6, 2018 Sherwood Hills Golf Club

Organized and conducted by the National Golf Association of the Philippines (NGAP) Supported by PLDT Group National Amateur Golf Tour

# **CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION**

The Championship shall be managed by a Committee.

#### 1. General

The championship is a 72-hole STROKE PLAY for Boys and Girls who are **17 years old and below as of April 3, 2018**. The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf effective January 2016 as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, and the Local Rules of *Sherwood Hills Golf & Country* Club as approved by the Tournament Committee.

### 2. Eligibility

3. Open to men amateur golfers with certified handicap index of 8.0 below and 10.0 below for women. Based on certified handicap index, the championship is limited to 90men players with the lowest handicap index and 42women players with the lowest handicap index. The Championship Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason thereof.

There will be a **Special Division** as follows:

- A. 18 years old and above (one division for both Boys & Girls) 4 days (April 3-6)
- B. 12 years old and below (one division for both Boys & Girls) 3 days (April 4-6)

#### 4. Cut-Off

Only the top **40 players** (Men) and ties will qualify for the final 2 rounds. Only the top **20 players** (Women) and ties will qualify for the final 2 rounds.

### 5. Schedule of Play

- April 2, 2018 (Monday) -Practice Round
- April 3, 2018 (Tuesday) 1<sup>st</sup> Round
- April 4, 2018 (Wednesday) 2<sup>nd</sup> Round
- April 5, 2018 (Thursday) 3<sup>rd</sup> Round
- April 6, 2018 (Friday) Final Round

### 6. <u>Ties</u>

In the event of tie/s for the 1<sup>st</sup> places after 72 holes, the tie/s shall be resolved via a hole-by-hole play-off. The holes for the play-off will be determined by the Championship Committee and announced before the start of the final round. In case of tie/s for other places, it will be resolved via count back as follows: (1) best score over the last 18 holes, (2) best score over the last 9 holes, (3) best score over the last 6 holes, (4) best score over the last 3 holes, (5) hole by hole count back starting at hole #18 of the last round.

## 7. Returning Scorecards upon completion of round

Players are reminded of their responsibilities under Rule 6-6(b) which states:

"Signing and Returning Card: After completion of the round, the competitor should check their score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the Committee. They shall ensure that the marker has signed the card, countersign the card themselves and return it to the Committee <u>as soon as possible</u>."

(Penalty for breach of Rule 6-6(b) – Disqualification.)

If a competitor does not return his/her card within 15 minutes of completion of the round (without valid reason) he/she will be subject to disqualification. The recorder's area is located at the Clubhouse beside the Tournament office. A scorecard is deemed to have been submitted the moment he/she drops it inside the drop box.

#### 8. Tees

## Championship Division and Special Division (18yrs old & above) - April 3-6 (4days)

**Boys** will tee off from the Gold Tees/Championship Tees

Girls will tee off from the White Tees

### Special Division (12yrs old & below) - April 4-6 (3days)

Boys will tee off from the White Tees

Girls will tee off from the Red Tees

## 9. Caddy

A player will be allowed to bring their own personal caddy provided the caddy is not a professional and subject to the rules and regulation of Sherwood Hills Golf and CC.

#### 9. Spectators

Spectators shall not exchange conversations with player and are strictly confined on the cart path to watch the game and shall at all times, keep a distance of not less than 20 meters from all players. If a serious breach has occurred, the spectator will be advised to leave the facility.

## 10. Awards

Championship Division – Champion, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-Up Special Division (18yrs old & above) – Champion only Special Division (12yrs old & below) – Champion, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Runner-Up

#### 11. Weather

In the event of inclement weather which may render the course unplayable, or in the event of lack of adequate daylight thus preventing any competitor from completing a round, Rules 33-2 (d) and 6-8 shall apply and the result of the championship shall be decided by the number of rounds completed within the time limit set by the Committee.

- **12.** <u>Distance-measuring device</u>. In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.
- **13.** <u>Mobile Phones:</u> The use of cell phone and similar devices is discouraged as it may delay or disturb the game. A player may be warned by a referee or other tournament officials to further refrain from using such device. The continuous use of such device after being warned could be grounds for disqualification.

### 14. Dress Code

- **a.** Players must be properly attired on the golf course. Blue jeans, designer jeans, round neck T-shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Golf shirts must be worn and shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh (no jean shorts).
- **b.** This dress code will be used in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the host club. A player violating this dress code will not be permitted to start the tournament. A violation of this dress code by a player during the stipulated round must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not be allowed to continue play.
- c. Soft spikes shoes are compulsory.
