CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

The Championship shall be managed by a Committee.

1. GENERAL

The Championship is a 54-holes stroke play competition for the Men and Ladies Championship Divisions, and 36-holes stroke play competition for the Mid-Amateur, Seniors & Special Divisions. The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, USGA and the Local Rules of Riviera Golf Club (Langer) as approved by the NGAP and Riviera Tournament Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- A. **Championship Division** - open to all men and women amateur golfers with handicap 0-8 for men and 0-11 for women.
- B. **Mid-Amateur Division**- male and female golfers 25 years and above as of November 10, 2018.
- C. **Senior's Division** - male and female golfers 55 years and above as of November 10, 2018.
- D. **Special Division** - boys & girls 12 years old & below as of November 10, 2018.

HANDICAP: October 2018 Handicap Index will be used for all groups.

5. AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded to:

- A. Championship Division (Men & Women): Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.
- B. Mid-Amateur: Champion and runner-up for Gross scores and Champion and runner-up for net scores.
- C. Senior's Division: Champion and runner-up for Gross Scores and Champion and runner up for net scores.
- D. Special Division: Champion and runner-up winners.

6. TIMES OF STARTING AND TEE

It is the responsibility of the Committee to establish the time of starting and to arrange the group in which competitors play.

- A. **Championship Division** - November 9, 10 & 11, 2018 (Friday, Saturday & Sunday)
Men's Division – Championship Tees
Ladies Division – White Tees
- B. **Mid-Amateur and Seniors Division** - November 10 & 11, 2018 (Saturday & Sunday)
Mid-Amateur Division – Blue Tees
Seniors Division – White Tees
- C. **Special Division - Boys & Girls 12 yrs old & below** - November 10 & 11, 2018 (Saturday & Sunday)
Boys 11-12 years old – White Tees
Boys 10years old & below – Red Tees
Girls 12 years old & below – Red Tees

7. TIE/S

In the event of ties for 1st place in any division, ties will be resolved via a hole-by-hole sudden death play-off. The holes for the play-off will be determined by the Committee and announced before the start of the final round. In case of ties for other places, it will be resolved via count back as follows: (1) best score over the last 18 holes, (2) best score over the last 9 holes, (3) best score over the last 6 holes, (4) best score over the last 3 holes, and if still tied hole by hole count back starting at the 18th hole of the final round.

8. WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather which may render the course unplayable, or in the event of lack of adequate daylight thus preventing any competitor from completing a round, Rules 33-2 (d) and 6-8 shall apply and the result of the championship shall be decided by the number of rounds completed within the time limit set by the Committee.

9. GOLF CARTS

The Championship division for men's and ladies will not be allowed to use golf carts.

10. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

In this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If during a round a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge other conditions that might affect his play (gradient, wind, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

11. COMMITTEE

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change any of the conditions of play, to fix and/or alter the starting times of a flight at any time for the best interest of the Championship.

The decision of the Rules Committee and the Championship Committee shall be final.
