# **TERMS OF COMPETITION**

# GENERAL

The **2023 NGAP Canlubang Open** will be played at Canlubang Golf & Country Club from March 14-17, 2023 in accordance with the Rules of Golf (effective January 2023) as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules approved by the OC.

# ELIGIBILITY

- A. Elite Amateur Division open to all amateur golfers with handicap <u>0-8</u> for men and <u>0-12</u> for women as of March 2023.
- **B.** Mid-Amateur Division I open to male golfers 25 to 40 years old as of March 14, 2023.
- C. Mid-Amateur Division II open to male golfers 41 to 54 years old as of March 14, 2023.
- **D.** Seniors Open Division open to male golfers 55 to 64 years old as of March 14, 2023.
- E. Super Senior Division open to male golfers 65 years and above as of March 14, 2023.

# FORMAT OF PLAY

- A. Elite Amateur Division March 14-17 (Tues-Fri) 4 days
  - The Elite Division (Men & Women) shall be gross stroke play competition over <u>72 holes</u> using the **gold tees** for Men and **white tees** for Women.
  - There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes, top 21 and ties for men, top 15 and ties for women
  - Players that score 95 on any tournament round will be cut for remaining rounds
- B. Mid-Amateur Division I & II March 15-17 (Wed-Fri) 3 days
  - The Mid-Amateur Division I & II shall be gross stroke play competition over <u>54 holes</u> using the blue tees.
  - There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes, top 12 in each division
  - Players that score 95 on any tournament round will be cut for remaining rounds
- C. Seniors Open Division March 15-17 (Wed-Fri) 3 days
  - The Seniors Open shall be gross stroke play competition over <u>54 holes</u> using the white tees.
  - There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes, top 15
  - Players that score 100 on any tournament round will be cut for remaining rounds

# D. Super Seniors Open Division - March 16-17 (Thu-Fri) - 2 days

- The Super Senior Division shall be gross stroke play competition over <u>36 holes</u> using the white tees.
- There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes, top 9
- Players that score 100 on any tournament round will be cut for remaining rounds

# *Note:* Players disqualified on the first day will not be allowed to play on the second day.

# WINNERS and PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to:

- A. Elite Amateur Division (Men): Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.
- B. Elite Amateur Division (Women): Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.
- C. Mid-Amateur Division I: Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.
- D. Mid-Amateur Division II: Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.
- E. Seniors Open Division: Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.
- F. Super Senior Division: Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up winners.

# ENTRY

- a. Elite Amateur Division (Men & Women) The Entry Fee shall be **Php4,000.00** for Filipino citizens and **Php4,500.00** for foreign citizens.
- b. Mid-Amateur Division I & II & Seniors Open Division The Entry Fee shall be **Php3,000.00** for Filipino citizens and **Php4,000.00** for foreign citizens.
- c. Super Seniors Open Division The Entry Fee shall be **Php2,500.00** for Filipino citizens and **Php3,500.00** for foreign citizens.
- d. Entries must be made via google form.

  Entry application is open from February 10, 8:00am to February 24, 5:00pm.
- e. Once your slot in the tournament is confirmed by NGAP via email, the entry fee shall be paid via online bank transfer.
- f. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit, accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason whatsoever. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- g. Any WITHDRAWAL or CANCELLATION must be made before **February 28, 2023 at 5:00pm** as there will be NO refund of the Entry Fee after this date.
- h. If a player must withdraw due to injury or illness during competition proper, they must inform any rules official on course and send any form of notification to tournament office.

# PRACTICE ROUND

- a. Players will be allowed one (1) free practice round from March 7-10, 2023 provided they have registered and paid their entry fee.
- b. Additional practice rounds can be arranged at Canlubang Golf & Country Club and corresponding green fee is paid.

# DRAW/PAIRINGS

- a. The Draw/Pairings for the First Round will be made by the Organizing Committee before the start of the Championship.
- b. The Draw/Pairings for the Second and Final rounds will be based on scores of the previous Rounds.

# TIME OF STARTING

- a. Players shall start at the time and order indicated in the DRAW. No substitution of players and changes of starting time shall be allowed after the DRAW has been made.
- b. The ORGANIZING COMMITTEE reserves the right to change and alter the starting times without giving any reason.

# SIZE of the FIELD

- a. The field will be limited to a maximum of 120 players.
- In the event that the entries fall short or exceed of the aforesaid respective numbers, the Committee reserves the right to amend the eligibility requirements as they deem fit.
  In general, entries will be based on the entrants with the Lowest Handicap Index.

### SUBMISSION of SCORECARD

- a. Players **must check** their cards in the Scoring Office and ensure that their scores are correct and be signed by their markers. Any doubtful point should be settled with the Organizing Committee before returning the scorecard.
- b. Scorecard is deemed officially submitted once the player has left the scoring room (area).

# **DECISION OF TIES**

- a. In the event of a tie or ties for the First place, the Champion shall be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off starting at Hole #1 until a winner is determined. The play-off will to determine the Champion only.
- b. All other ties will be decided by count back in the following order:
  - \*. Last 18 holes (1<sup>st</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>);
  - \*. Last 9 holes (10<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>);
  - \*. Last 6 holes (13<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>)
  - \*. Last 3 holes (16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>)
  - \*. Last hole (18<sup>th</sup>)

# SUSPENSION OF PLAY FOR DANGEROUS SITUATION

- a. A suspension of play for a dangerous situation and the resumption of play shall be signaled using the host club's warning system.
- b. All open practice areas shall be closed during suspension for a dangerous situation until the Organizing Committee has declared them open. Players who does not heed will be subject to disqualification.

# USE OF DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

- b. For this Championship, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance- measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.) The player is in breach of Rule 4.3 for which the penalty is for disqualification.
- c. The use of rangefinders with wind and slope corrections are not permitted.

# **USE OF CADDIE**

a. The club has sufficient caddies and players must use the club's caddies, however, personal caddies may be used, provided they are not PROFESSIONALS and the player must pay the corresponding caddy fee to the Club for the caddy on deck.

#### **USE OF GOLF CARTS**

Golf Carts will be allowed for the Mid-Am and Senior Division Golf Carts are NOT allowed in Elite Amateur Division.

#### INSURANCE

a. All players are required to have appropriate golfing insurance.

#### PACE OF PLAY

- a. Each hole has been given a maximum completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the Hole. The maximum allotted time for completion of 18 holes will be available prior to the round.
- b. The maximum allowed time allocated per shot is 40 seconds. The timing will start when the player has
- had sufficient time to reach his ball, it is his turn to play and he is able to play without interference or distraction. c. Penalty for Brach of Condition
  - 1 bad time. Player will be warned by the referee and told that further bad will be subject to penalty.
  - 2 bad time. Penalty of one (1) Stroke
  - 3 bad time. Further penalty of two (2) strokes.
  - 4 bad time. Disqualification.

### TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIALS/REFEREES

a. The Tournament Rules Officials/Referees' decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is final.

### **COMPETITION CLOSED**

a. When the prizes are presented to the winners, the results of the competition are deemed officially announced and the competition is closed.

### STANDARDS OF PLAYER CONDUCT (Rule 1-2)

- a. All players ARE EXPECTED TO PLAY IN THE SPIRIT OF THE GAME. There is no penalty under the Rules for failing to act accordingly, except that the Organizing Committee may disqualify a player for acting contrary to the spirit of the if it is established that the player has committed serious misconduct.
- b. The following may be considered as serious breach of PLAYER CONDUCT:
  - \*. Continuous use of cellular phones during the round. Players will be warned accordingly by the Referee or by a committee member.
  - \*. Verbal abuse to a fellow competitor/official/staff.
  - \*. Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitor.
  - \*. Causing unnecessary damage to the course or club property.
  - \*. Any other action which may be considered to be breach of PLAYER CONDUCT.

ANY OF THE ABOVE SERIOUS BREACH of Conduct is subject to disqualification penalty.

### SPECTATORS/COACHES/PARENTS

- a. Spectators, coaches, and parents must remain on the cart path at all times. They must stay off the tees, general areas, putting greens, bunkers and penalty areas. They are allowed to use golf carts.
- b. They should maintain a reasonable distance from the players to avoid the impression that they are giving advice or assisting the player in any way. They may approach the player for a moment to give clothing, food or beverage but should not have prolonged contact.
- c. Those found to be violating these policies may be asked to leave the COURSE.
