TERMS OF COMPETITION

GENERAL

The 2023 Northern Luzon Regional Golf Championship (herein known as 'Championship') will be played at Camp John Hay Golf Club from May 23-26, 2023 in accordance with the Rules of Golf (effective January 2023) as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules approved by the OC.

ELIGIBILITY

- A. Men's Elite Amateur open to male amateur golfers with maximum handicap of 8.0
- B. Women's Elite Amateur open to female amateur golfers with maximum handicap of 8.0
- C. Mixed Division I open to male and female golfers with handicap of 8.1 13.0
- D. Mixed Division II open to male and female golfers with handicap of 13.1 18.0
- E. Senior Division open to male golfers 55 & above with maximum handicap index of 18.0 *All WHS handicaps to be used will be as of April 14, 2023

FORMAT OF PLAY / SCHEDULE

A. Elite Amateur Divisions - May 23-26 (Tues-Fri) - 4 days

- The Elite Division (Men & Women) shall be gross stroke play competition over 72 holes using the gold tees for Men and white tees for Women.
- o There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes, top 21 and ties for men and 12 and ties for women will advance.
- o The Champion of each division shall be the players with the lowest aggregate score over 72 holes.
- Players scoring 95 on any championship round will be cut for the remaining round/s.

B. Mixed Division I & II - May 24-26 (Wed-Fri) - 3 days

- o The Mixed Division I & II shall be gross stroke play competition over 54 holes using the blue tees for the men and red tees for the women.
- There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes, top 12 and ties for each division will advance.
- o The three (3) lowest gross over 54 in both divisions will be awarded

C. Senior Division - May 25-26 (Thu-Fri) - 2 days

- o The Senior Division shall be gross stroke play competition over 36 holes using the white tees.
- The three (3) lowest gross over 36 holes will be awarded.

ENTRY

- A. Entry Application must be made via google form link: https://bit.ly/2023NGAP_NorthernLuzonRegional a. Application is open from April 24, 8:00am to May 10, 5:00pm.
- B. Once your slot in the tournament is confirmed via email after entries close, the entry fee shall be paid via bank transfer.
- C. Entry fees are as follows:

*CJH members receive 50% discount. Entry Fees do not cover caddies, golf carts and incidentals.

- D. In general, entries will be based on the entrants with the Lowest Handicap Index.
- E. Confirmed entries, must pay entry fee by **May 17**. Failure to do so will result in loss of slot in tournament and will not be included in pairings.
- F. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- G. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit, accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason whatsoever.

SIZE OF FIELD

A. Maximum field size will be:

B. In the event that entries fall short or exceed of the aforesaid respective numbers, the Committee reserves the right to amend the distribution or eligibility requirements as they deem fit.

WIDTHRAWAL/CANCELLATION/NO SHOWS

- A. Any withdrawal or cancelation must be made before **May 17, 2023** (Wednesday) as there will be NO refund of the Entry Fee after this date.
- B. Strict NO SHOW POLICY will be enforced.
 - a. Any player confirmed for the event who fails to show up without giving prior notice will automatically be suspended for the next NGAP sanctioned event.
 - b. Any player with two (2) no shows within a twelve (12) month period will be suspended from all NGAP events for the next twelve (12) months.
- C. If a player must withdraw due to injury or illness during competition proper, they must inform any rules official on course and send any form of notification to tournament office.
- D. Habitual Withdrawal/Cancellation/No Card/No show will be review by Tournament committee and proper suspensions may be handed out.

WINNERS and PRIZES

PRACTICE ROUND

- A. Players will be allowed one (1) free practice round on May 22, Monday for ELITE, May 23, Tuesday (12:00 onwards) provided they have registered and paid their entry fee.
- B. Additional practice rounds can be arranged with Camp John Hay and the corresponding green fee is paid. You may call Camp John Hay at Tel. No. (047) 444 2561.

DRAW/PAIRINGS

- A. The Draw/Pairings for the First and Second Rounds will be made by the Organizing Committee before the start of the Championship.
- B. The Draw/Pairings for the Third and Final rounds will be based on scores of the previous Rounds.

TIME OF STARTING

- A. Players shall start at the time and order indicated in the DRAW. No substitution of players and changes of starting time shall be allowed after the DRAW has been made.
- B. The organizing committee reserves the right to change and alter the starting times without giving any reason.

SUBMISSION of SCORECARD

- A. Players must check their cards in the Scoring Office and ensure that their scores are correct and be signed by their markers. Any doubtful point should be settled with the Organizing Committee before returning the Scorecard
- B. Scorecard is deemed officially submitted once the player has left the scoring room (area).

DECISION OF TIES

- A. In the event of a tie or ties for the First place, the Champion shall be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off starting at Hole #1 until a winner is determined. Play-off will be used to determine the Champion only.
- B. All other ties will be decided by count back in the following order:
 - Last 18 holes (1st-18th).
 - Last 9 holes (10th-18th).
 - Last 6 holes (13th-18th)
 - Last 3 holes (16th-18th)
 - o Last hole (18th)

SUSPENSION OF PLAY FOR DANGEROUS SITUATION.

- A. A suspension of play for a dangerous situation and the resumption of play shall be signaled using the host club's warning system.
- B. All open practice areas shall be closed during suspension for a dangerous situation until the Organizing Committee has declared them open. Players who do not heed will be subject to disqualification.

USE OF DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE.

- A. For this Championship, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance- measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.) The player is in breach of Rule 4.3 for which the penalty is for disqualification.
- B. The use of rangefinders with wind and slope corrections are not permitted.

USE OF CADDIE & MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION

A. The club has sufficient caddies and players in all divisions must use the club's caddies.

Caddie Fee: P700.00 minimum (tips are encouraged)

B. Motorized transportation will be allowed in Division I, Division II & Senior's Division

Golf Cart: P1000.00/sharing & P800/solo

Note: Golf Carts are not allowed in Elite Amateur Division.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- A. Use of electronic devices must be kept to a minimum.
- B. Mobile Phones may be used to call organizing committee for rulings.
- C. Mobile phones may be used as range finders as long as DMD restrictions above are adhered to.
- D. Phones may not be used for calls and/or entertainment in the field of play during the stipulated round.
- E. Any device to play music or similar audio or entertainment will not be permitted.

1 offense Player will be warned by the referee.

2 offense Penalty of one (1) Stroke

3 offense Further penalty of two (2) strokes.

4 offense Disqualification.

INSURANCE

All players are required to have appropriate golfing insurance.

PACE OF PLAY

- A. Each hole has been given a maximum completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the Hole. The maximum allotted time for completion of 18 holes will be available prior to the round.
- B. The maximum allowed time allocated per shot is 40 seconds. The timing will start when the player has had sufficient time to reach his ball, it is his turn to play and he is able to play without interference or distraction.

Penalty for Brach of Condition

1 bad time Player will be warned by the referee

2 bad time. Penalty of one (1) Stroke

3 bad time. Further penalty of two (2) strokes.

4 bad time. Disqualification.

TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIALS/REFEREES

The Tournament Rules Officials/Referees' decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is final.

COMPETITION CLOSED

When the prizes are presented to the winners, the results of the competition are deemed officially announced and the competition is closed.

STANDARDS OF PLAYER CONDUCT (Rule 1-2)

All players ARE EXPECTED TO PLAY IN THE SPIRIT OF THE GAME. There is no penalty under the Rules for failing to act accordingly, except that the Organizing Committee may disqualify a player for acting contrary to the spirit of the if it is established that the player has committed serious misconduct.

The following may be considered as serious breach of PLAYER CONDUCT

- Verbal abuse to a fellow competitor/official/staff.
- Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitor.
- o Causing unnecessary damage to the course or club property.
- Any other action which may be considered to be breach of player conduct.

ANY BREACH of Player Conduct is subject to disqualification penalty.

SPECTATORS/COACHES/PARENTS

- A. Spectators, coaches, and parents are allowed but must rent a golf cart from the golf club.
- B. Carts will be on a first come first serve basis, and subject to availability of carts. Members and players in tournament will be prioritized in cart assignment.
- C. All spectators must remain on the cart path at all times. They must stay off the tees, general areas, putting greens, bunkers and penalty areas. They are allowed to use golf carts if course permits.
- D. They should maintain a reasonable distance from the players to avoid the impression that they are giving advice or assisting the player in any way. They may approach the player for a moment to give clothing, food or beverage but should not have prolonged contact.
- E. Those found to be violating these policies may be asked to leave the COURSE.
