



## 2024 IMG JUNIOR WORLD NGAP QUALIFIERS (7 – 12 YEARS OLD)

Philippine Navy Golf Club  
May 6–8, 2024  
(Monday to Wednesday)

### TERMS OF COMPETITION

#### GENERAL

The National Golf Association of the Philippines (NGAP) presents the 2024 IMG Junior World NGAP Qualifiers which will be played at the Philippine Navy Golf Club from May 6-8, 2024. The qualifier will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf (effective March 2024) as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules approved by the Organizing Committee.

- This tournament will serve as qualifying to the 2024 IMG Junior World Championships, which will be held in its respective golf courses in California, USA.

#### ELIGIBILITY

The 2024 IMG Junior World NGAP Qualifiers are open to Filipino players with a **valid Philippine Passport**, and **expiry date must be after January 15, 2025**.

#### FORMAT OF PLAY

- The Championship is 54 holes gross stroke-play. The schedule and format will be as follows:
 

May 6, 2024 (Mon)	1st Round	18 holes
May 7, 2024 (Tues)	2nd Round	18 holes
May 8, 2024 (Wed)	Final Round	18 holes
- There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes. **Only top 10 per division and players within 8 strokes from the 4<sup>th</sup> placer will advance to the Final Round.**
- Any player who shoots 100 and above for any round shall be cut from the qualifiers.**

#### SIZE OF THE FIELD

- The field will be limited to a maximum of **100 players**.
- In the event that the entries fall short or exceed of the aforesaid respective numbers, the Committee reserves the right to amend the eligibility requirements as they deem fit.
- Entries will be prioritized according to the Lowest Handicap Index.

## ENTRY

- a. Entries must be made via google form.

Entry application is open until April 21, 2024.
- b. Once your slot in the tournament is confirmed via email, the entry fee shall be paid via bank transfer.
  - **Entry Fee – P4,000**
- c. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit, accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason whatsoever. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- d. **Any WITHDRAWAL or CANCELLATION must be made via email before April 26, 2024 at 5:00pm** as there will be NO refund of the Entry Fee after this date.
- e. Strict NO SHOW POLICY will be enforced.
- f. If a player must withdraw due to injury or illness during competition proper, they must inform any rules official on course and send any form of notification to tournament office.
- g. Habitual Withdrawal/Cancellation/No Card/No show will be review by Tournament committee and proper suspensions may be handed out.

## OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND

Practice rounds can be coordinated directly with Philippine Navy Golf Club.

## DRAW/PAIRINGS

- a. The Draw/Pairings for the first round will be made by the Organizing Committee before the start of the Qualifiers.
- b. The Draw/Pairings for the 2nd and final round will be according to score.
- c. Pairing requests will not be entertained.

## TIME OF STARTING

- a. Players shall start at the time and order indicated in the draw/pairings.
- b. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change and alter the start times as they deem necessary.

## WINNERS AND PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded: Certificates for Qualifiers

## SUBMISSION of SCORECARD

- a. Players must check their cards in the Scoring Office and ensure that their scores are correct and be signed by their markers. Any doubtful point should be settled with the Organizing Committee before returning the Scorecard.
- b. Scorecard is deemed officially submitted once the player has left the scoring room (area).

## DECISION OF TIES

All ties will be decided by count back. The count back procedure to be used will be as follows:

- a. Last 18 holes
- b. Last nine holes (10 to 18)
- c. Last six holes (13 to 18)
- d. Last three holes (16 to 18)
- e. Then hole by hole starting from the last hole (18, 17, 16...)
- f. If there is still no result then the winner shall be decided by the toss of a coin

## SUSPENSION OF PLAY FOR DANGEROUS SITUATION

- a. A suspension of play for a dangerous situation and the resumption of play shall be signaled using the host club's warning system.
- b. All open practice areas shall be closed during suspension for a dangerous situation until the Organizing Committee has declared them open. Players who do not heed will be subject to disqualification.

## USE OF DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

- a. For this Qualifier, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance- measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.). The player is in breach of Rule - 4.3 for which the penalty is for disqualification.
- b. The use of rangefinders with wind and slope corrections are not permitted.

## USE OF CADDIE

Only players in the 7–8 and 9–10 age divisions may use a caddie. Only accredited caddies of the Philippine Navy Golf Club are allowed for ALL players under these age divisions. Players under these divisions are not permitted to have personal caddies.

Players in the 11–12 division are not allowed to have personal nor club caddies. Only the player will be allowed to handle the player's equipment, Players must not take more than 40 seconds to play a shot, counting from the time his/her turn to play is up. If a player takes more than 40 seconds, he or she will be subjected to a penalty.

To avoid any player experiencing over-fatigue or heatstroke during the qualifiers, each flight will be assigned 2 golf carts, with one caddie driving each golf cart. Players are required to put their golf bags on the golf carts. Players may put their beverages and snacks on the golf carts, as well.

A player may not ride the golf cart at any point during the round. A player may not seek for any help nor advise from the caddies assigned to driving the golf carts. The caddies may only rake the bunkers and repair the divots.

Philippine Navy Golf Club will be charging P900 per player per day upon registration at the clubhouse. This P900 per player per day will cover the following:

- Payment for caddie
- Payment for golf cart rental

## USE OF GOLF CART

Motorized transportation is not allowed.

## INSURANCE & MISCELLANEOUS FEES

All players are required to pay the golf insurance and miscellaneous fees required by the Philippine Navy Golf Club.

## PACE OF PLAY

- a. Each hole has been given a maximum completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the Hole. The maximum allotted time for completion of 18 holes will be available prior to the round.
- b. The maximum allowed time allocated per shot is 40 seconds. The timing will start when the player has had sufficient time to reach his ball, it is his turn to play and he is able to play without interference or distraction.
- c. However an extra 10 seconds is allowed for the first player to play:
  - i. Tee shot on a par 3 hole.
  - ii. Second shot on par 4's and par 5's.
  - iii. From on or near the putting green at any hole.
- d. The timing will start when it is the player's turn to play and there is no interference or distraction.
- e. Penalty for Breach of Condition

1 bad time	Player will be warned by the referee and told that further bad will be subject to penalty.
2 bad time.	Penalty of one (1) Stroke
3 bad time.	Further penalty of two (2) strokes.
4 bad time.	Disqualification.

## TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIALS/REFEREES

The Tournament Rules Officials/Referees' decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is final.

## COMPETITION CLOSED

When the prizes are presented to the winners, the results of the competition are deemed officially announced and the competition is closed.

## STANDARDS OF PLAYER CONDUCT (Rule 1-2)

- a. All players ARE EXPECTED TO PLAY IN THE SPIRIT OF THE GAME. There is no penalty under the Rules for failing to act accordingly, except that the Organizing Committee may disqualify a player for acting contrary to the spirit of the if it is established that the player has committed serious misconduct.
- b. The following may be considered as serious breach of PLAYER CONDUCT:
  - Continuous use of cellular phones during the round. Players will be warned accordingly by the Referee or by a committee member.
  - Verbal abuse to a fellow competitor/official/staff.
  - Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitor.
  - Causing unnecessary damage to the course or club property.
  - Any other action which may be considered to be breach of PLAYER CONDUCT.

**SPECTATORS/COACHES/PARENTS**

- a. Spectators, coaches, and parents **MUST REMAIN ON CART PATH** at all times. They must stay off the tees, general areas, putting greens, bunkers and penalty areas. They are allowed to use golf carts and will be given on a first come first serve basis.
- b. They should maintain a reasonable distance from the players to avoid the impression that they are giving advice or assisting the player in any way.
- c. Those found to be violating these policies may be asked to leave the **COURSE**.
- d. Players' parents will be responsible for paying for any gallery related fees.
